<u>Sub - Selection for admission to PhD programme under QIP- Advance Admission in PhD (Pre registration Programme) during 2018-2019 leading to final admission during 2019-2020.</u>

Sir/Madam,

With reference to your application for admission to PhD programme under QIP in our institute and as per the NQCC recommendation (Vide Ref no 2018/QIP-Admission/22 dated 21/05/2018), I am glad to inform you that you have been selected for this programme in the department of Civil Engineering. As you are aware, the admission is under the scheme of advance selection for the PhD programme as approved by AICTE.

In accordance with the provision of this selection, you are required to visit the Department of Civil Engineering during the period August 2018 to May 2019 to decide the research problem, carry out literature survey and other preparatory work under the supervision of your prospective guide and the Head of the department. The total duration of your visit should not exceed 60 days ( Sixty Days) which you may spread over 2 to 4 visits, each visit being a period of 20 days or more. For each visit you will be paid second class return railway fare/actual bus fare by the shortest route and per diem allowance Rs. 100/- per day or as per the prevailing rules (only for out station candidates) for your stay at the institute. You must commence your visit as early as possible after 1<sup>st</sup> August 2018 but not later than 31<sup>st</sup> December 2018 and complete the 60 days pre registration training within 31<sup>st</sup> May 2019. It may please be noted that your number of visits should not exceed four. Your first visit should be planned in consultation with Head of the Department over phone number 0240-2366150/9822115626 for allotment of guide and thereafter in consultation with the research guide.

On your first visit, you have to meet the Dean Academic or Head of the Department with all certificates in the prescribed format as given in Annexure I to VI (enclosed). Also you should bring a relieving order (Annexure VI) from Principal during each of your visit to the institute under scheme of advance selection clearly mentioning the period of your stay at the institute. For accommodation you have to write in advance to Principal, Government College of Engineering, Aurangabad.

You are required to

- a) Submit a complete pre registration form Part-I at the beginning of each visit itself.
- b) Identify the specific area of your research and the research supervisor.
- c) Chalk out your program for your future visits (During each visit).
- d) Prepare a brief report (at least 2 pages) as per Part-II at the end of each visit.

Further your final registration will be subject to compliance of requirements of Dr. Babasaheb

Ambedkar Marathwada University, like PET examination and appearing before RRC or any other requirement as specified by the university time to time.

Only on satisfactory completion of 60 days training at the institute and compliance with all the requirements, an official admission letter will be sent enabling you to join the PhD program commencing from 1<sup>st</sup> August 2018. Please note that your admission to the PhD programme is subject to furnishing the following at the time of joining the institute.

- a) Certificate of AICTE recognition in the standard format (Copy Enclosed)
- b) A sponsorship certificate from the Principal, stating that you have been sponsored under the QIP and that you are on deputation for three years with full salary and allowances and that you have executed a bond to your parent institution stating that you will serve your institution for a minimum period of three years after completion of your programme.
- c) Relieving order clearly mentioning the period i.e. 01/07/2019 to 31/06/2022.

You are requested to confirm within 15 days of receipt of this letter and your acceptance of the offer of admission, further to which the admission will be offered to the next candidate in the waiting list.
