Sub: Selection for admission to Ph.D.Program under QIP-Advance Admission to Ph.D(pre-registration program) during 2013-14 to final admission during 2014-15

Sir/Madam,

With reference to your application for admission to the Ph.D. programme under QIP in our Institute, I am glad to inform you that you have been selected for this program in Department of Electronics and Communication Engineering, as you are aware, the admission is under scheme of advance selection for the Ph.D. program as approved by AICTE.

In accordance with the provision of this selection, you are required to visit the department of Electronics and Communication Engineering during the period August 2013-March 2014 to decide the research problem, carry out literature survey and other preparatory work under the supervision of your prospective guide and the Chairman of the Department. The total duration of your visit should not exceed 60 days (sixty days) which you may spread over to 2 to 4 visits, each visit being for a period of 15 days or more. For each visit you will be paid second class return railway fare/actual bus fare by the shortest route and per diem allowance at Rs.125/ per day. (for only outstation candidates) for your stay at the institute/college. You must commence your visit as early as possible after 1st August 2013, but not later than 31st December 2013 and complete the 60 day pre registration training within 30th March 2014. It may please be noted that your number of visits should not exceed four. Your first visit should be planned in consultation with the Chairman, DRC, Department of Electronics and Communication Engineering over phone 91-240-2366251 and thereafter in consultation with Research Supervisor.

On your first visit, you have to meet the head of Department with all the certificates in the prescribed format as given in Annexure I to VI (enclosed). Also you should bring a relieving order (Annexure VI) from the Principal during each of your visit to college under scheme of advance selection clearly mentioning the period of your stay at the college. You are required to;

- Submit a completed pre registration form Part I at the beginning of each visit itself.
- Identify the specific area of your research and the research supervisor
- Chalk out your program for future visits


d. Prepare a brief report(at least two pages) as per part -2 at the end of each visit
Only on satisfactory completion of 60 days training at the college and compliance with all the requirement, an official admission letter will be sent enabling you to join Ph.D. Program commencing from 1st August 2014. Please note that your admission to the Ph.D.program is subject to furnishing the following at the time of joining the college.

- 1) A certificate of AICTE Recognition in the standard format(copy enclosed)
- 2) A sponsorship certificate from the Principal, stating that you have been sponsored under the QIP and that, you are on deputation for three years with full salary and allowances and that you have executed a bond to your parent institution stating that you will serve your institution for a minimum period of three years after completion of your program.
- 3) Relieving order clearly mentioning the period i.e. 01/08/2014-31/07/2017.

You are requested to confirm within 15 days of receipt of this letter, and your acceptance of the offer of admission.
