Sub: Extension of Autonomous Status of Government College of Engineering - reg.

Madam/Sir,

This is with reference to the proposal submitted by Government College of Engineering, Aurangabad, Osmanpura Chhatrapati Sambhajnagar, affiliated to Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar Marathwada University, Aurangabad, for the extension of autonomous status.

The Commission, in its meeting held on 23.07.2025, has approved the recommendation of the Standing Committee on Autonomous Colleges to extend the autonomous status to Government College of Engineering Aurangabad, Osmanpura, Chhatrapati Sambhajnagar-431005, affiliated to Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar Marathwada University, Aurangabad, Maharashtra, for a period of 05 years from the academic year 2024-2025 to 2028-2029, including *ex-post-facto approval of the condonation of the gap period (2024-2025)*, as per clause 8.1 of the UGC (Conferment of Autonomous Status Upon Colleges and Measures for Maintenance of Standards in Autonomous Colleges) Regulations, 2023.

The University is, therefore, requested to issue the necessary notification within 30 days regarding the extension of autonomous status to the College as per the above-mentioned UGC Regulations. The autonomous college is required to abide by all the provisions of the UGC Regulations for Autonomous Colleges, 2023. The Regulations are available on www.ugc.gov.in. Non-compliance with the requirements and conditions prescribed in the said Regulations shall attract action as per Clause -13 of the UGC Regulations, 2023. The college shall apply to the University Grants Commission for an extension of autonomous status at least three months before the completion of the period of autonomy.
