Activity: Report on Wings 2024.

Session Details:

Every year, the Government College of Engineering, Chh. Sambhajnagar hosts Wings, a national-level technical event for students across India to showcase their knowledge and skills. This year, the grand event was a three-day extravaganza from January 19th to 21st, 2024. Numerous seminars, competitions, and guest lectures were organized throughout the event for the benefit of the students. Below is a detailed report on Wings 2024.

Day 1:

Inauguration Ceremony:

Wings 2024 kicked off with an Inauguration Ceremony from 11 am to 12 pm. Around 200 students graced the ceremony. Chief Guest G. Shrikanth, Guest of Honor Sonalika Akhouri (Regional Officer, SBI, Chh. Sambhajnagar), Ravindra Sarade (Chief Manager, SBI Chh. Sambhajnagar), Anil Wagh (General Manager SBI Bansilal nagar branch), Shikhar Goel, U. T. Nagdive, Prasad Kokil, Suraj Dumne, along with esteemed faculty members Dr. S. S. Dambhare, Dr. A. S. 
Ode to Code:

Day 3:


Zumba Dance:
