**Important Notes:**

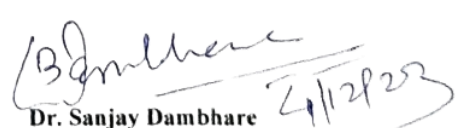
1. Attendance in classes is mandatory from the very beginning of the semester.
