Important Notes:

1. Course registration will be closed within 10 days from start of term. No one will be allowed to change the courses once opted after 10 days of commencement of term.
2. Students with less than 75% attendance will not be allowed to attend ISE-I and ISE-II. Students with less than 75% attendance will not be allowed for ESE
3. Attendance in classes is mandatory from the very beginning of the semester.
4. All the departments are requested to strictly adhere to the above schedule.
5. The industrial visits shall be scheduled incorporating Saturdays/Sundays/holidays as far as possible with intimation to other faculty members concerned with teaching for that class.
6. Saturdays and public holidays may be used to conduct Mid-semester and Semester end Examinations. However, effort is normally to be made to exclude Sundays for mandated academic activities, including examinations.
7. The department will be responsible for conducting 90 days of academic activity within specified term period. If 90 days are not completed use of Saturdays/Sundays and public holidays is recommended. The term will not be extended under any circumstances.
