- Meeting started by welcoming all honorable members by Dr. V. S Rajguru, Chairperson
- After confirmation of minutes of last meeting, the chairperson initiated the discussion on

- structure and curriculum of Minor Certification Programme (Electrical). After prolonged discussion, BoS (Electrical) approved the structure and curriculum of Minor Certification Programme (Electrical).
- The structure and curriculum of Honor Certification Programme (Electrical) has been explained by the chairperson. Dr. B. N. Chaudhari is of the opinion that there shall be a basket of PG core courses from which the student can opt 4 rather than forcing them to learn a particular course. All the BoS members agreed for the same and approved the structure and curriculum of Honor Certification Programme (Electrical).
- It is also suggested by BoS members that the Class Adviser shall guide the UG students not to opt those professional elective UG subjects which are available in the basket of Honor Programme, if they wish to register for Honor Certification Programme.
- Due to COVID19 situation, the courses are being taught online. Online teaching takes time to learn. Therefore, BoS strongly proposed to postpone the minor/honor programme till next academic year atleast.
- Also the student has to earn 176 credits for the regular degree course. An addition of 15 credits
 to get minor/honor certification will put an extra load on students. Therefore, BoS strongly
 proposed to reduce the credits of UG programme first and then implement minor and honor
 scheme.
- It was proposed to add few open elective courses in UG curriculum. Considering present scenario, Dr. B. N. Choudhari suggested to include the course Electric Vehicle as open elective. This was supported by Dr. Devlanlar and Dr. Vishwanathan. Hence new courses namely Industrial Automation and Control, Power Plant Engineering and Electric Vehicle are included to get more options to the students. BoS approved the open elective courses and the curriculum.
- The BoS also approved to include the course Energy and Environmental Policies in the existing list of open elective courses of PG programme. Its curriculum approved by the BoS.
- In any other point with chairperson's permission, Dr. V. S. Rajguru proposed to increase 1 credit in the course EE2001 Electromagnetic Field as the syllabus of the said subject is very vast and number of hours allotted are not sufficient to complete the syllabus. However, BoS members suggested to consider this point in the next revision of the curriculum. Hence not approved.

Meeting was ended with vote of thanks by the Chairperson.
