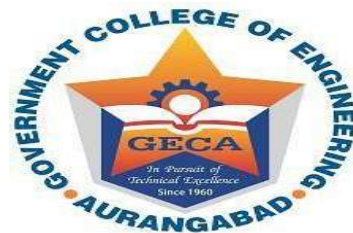


**Additions to the existing  
RULES AND REGULATIONS  
REGARDING CURRICULUM AS PER  
CHOICE BASED CREDIT SYSTEM  
FOR  
POST GRADUATE PROGRAMMES  
(Master of Computer Applications 2 Years MCA)**

As approved by the XXII Academic Council, Dated 23<sup>rd</sup> June 2021



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### **Background:**

The Academic Rules and Regulations Regarding Curriculum as per Choice Based Credit System for Post Graduate Programme MCA are in force. The Government has changed the programme duration of the MCA from 3 years to 2 years. In view of this the following additions are suggested to the existing rules and regulations. This is to be implemented from academic Year 2020-2021 onwards.

The following changes in the rules are listed below. Rest all existing rules and regulations will be in force.

### **3 ACADEMIC CALENDAR:**

3.1 The normal duration of the course leading to MCA degree will be **FOUR** semesters for full time.

4.2 **Lower and Upper Limits for Course Credits Registered in a Semester, by a Full-time Student of a post graduate Degree Programme:** A full time/part time student of a particular post graduate degree programme shall register for the appropriate number of course credits in each semester/session, that is within the minimum and maximum limits specific to that Post Graduate degree programme as stipulated in the specific Regulations pertaining to that degree programme as prescribed in **Annexure A.**

### **ANNEXURE-A REGULATIONS SPECIFIC TO POSTGRADUATE PROGRAMMES (MCA)**

#### **A3. COURSE STRUCTURE:**

**A3.4** The curriculum structure of Master of Computer Application Programme shall typically consist of the following components. 10% variation in suggested breakdown in each category is permitted subject to total credits of ----

1	<b>Humanities and Social Sciences (HS), Including Management</b>	<b>04</b>
2	<b>Professional Subjects - Core (PC)</b> Relevant to the chosen specialization/Branch; Laboratory-work	<b>56</b>
3	<b>Mini Project/ Seminar/ Dissertation etc.</b>	<b>27</b>
4	<b>Profession Subjects- Electives(PE)</b> Relevant to the chosen specialization/Branch;	<b>09</b>

### **A3.6 Lower and Upper Limits for Course Credits to be Registered in a Semester by the Students of**

#### **A3.6.1 MCA Degree Programme:**

- b) A student of the M.C.A. degree programme can register for a minimum of 14 credits in a Semester and up to a maximum of 24 credits per semester. However the minimum/maximum credit limit can be relaxed by the Principal and Dean (Academic) on the recommendations of the BoS only under extremely exceptional circumstances.

### **A4. DEGREE REQUIREMENTS:**

#### **Master of Computer Application Programme**

**A4.2** The degree requirements of a student for the M.C.A. programme are as follows:

- a) Minimum Earned Credit Requirements of all Core Courses, Elective Courses etc. mentioned in the curriculum. Minimum Earned Credit Requirement for Master of Computer Application Degree is 96.
- b) Satisfactory completion of all Non Credit Mandatory Courses as mentioned in the curriculum.
- c) The Maximum duration for a student for complying to the Degree Requirement as per affiliating university rules and UGC/AICTE guidelines. The MCA degree shall be awarded TWO (02) years after the admission and only after fulfilling requirements mentioned in A4.2 (a) and (b).

### **A5. Re-registration**

**A5.2** M.C.A. student shall be required to reregister for required courses, under the following circumstances:

<b>Check point</b>	<b>Credit Threshold</b>
End of First year	24

**Note:** The period of temporary withdrawal is not to be counted for the above Credit Threshold.
